The pilot teachers loved that BeeReaders provides access to a wide variety of authentic, culturally relevant Spanish texts and exposes students to new vocabulary from a range of Spanish-speaking countries.

- "Cultural exposure is a huge added value. Since we are located in the US, it is so helpful to have authentically written texts that are not the poorly translated texts the students are used to. It is a great way to expose students to different dialects and vocabulary."

Teachers appreciated that the comprehension questions were distributed throughout the reading selection and as students read, instead of only at the end of the reading. This feature helped students focus and become more self-directed and responsible learners, as well as being a time-saving tool for teachers.

- "A lot of the students who struggle with comprehension struggle to retain information about books when questions are at the end, so the questions appearing on each page were helpful in terms of their retention and comprehension building."
- "It kept their focus, I liked it. They knew they had to stay on task and that they were going to be tested."
- "I appreciated this, because even with my own class I would make them stop reading after each page and summarize what they had just read (with physical books)."

Teachers reported that BeeReaders is ideal for *independent work* and *during free reading time*, as students are able to explore the library, complete challenges, and buy items in the store on their own.
