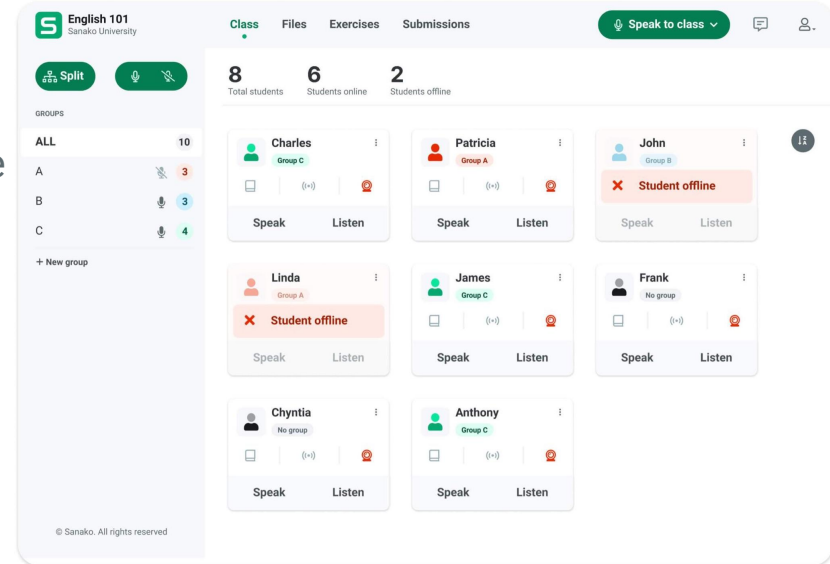

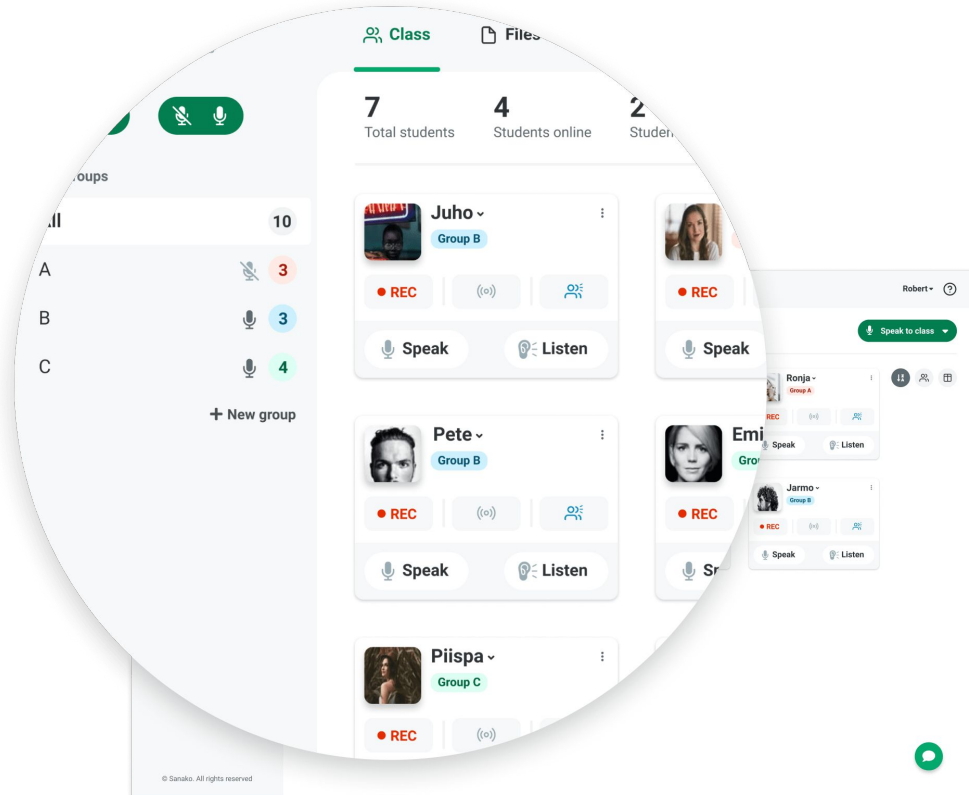
# What is Connect in a nutshell?

- The next generation language lab with the flexibility and scalability of modern technology: no installations needed, easy to maintain, flexible subscription based licensing, can be used in the classroom and remotely
- Allows live teaching and self-paced learning in the same solution
- Includes ready-made workflows for the most common speaking and listening activities and a flexible content authoring tool for creating any kinds of custom exercises



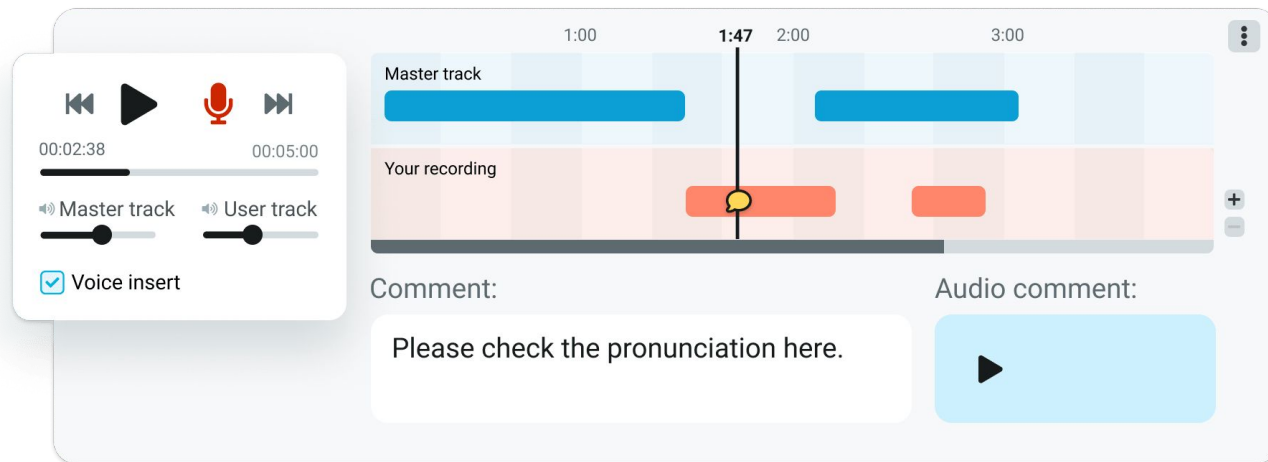
# Teacher-led solution allows teachers to be always in control

- Class view for the teacher to see the whole class and each student's status
- Teacher enabled text chat and audio/video calls
- Pair/group students for live discussion activities and role plays
- Monitor what each student is doing at any given time
- Launch teacher controlled activities that make sure students are focused on the task



# Designed for communicative language teaching

- Create and share speaking based tasks and pronunciation exercises and collect individual students' recording for targeted feedback and grading
- Practice and administer whole class simultaneous speaking exams and oral language assessments with teacher-controlled exercises



# Live teaching and self-paced learning in one solution


