### 1. Sign out of the current assignment.

### 2. Create a new teacher account.


Click **Sign-Up** and create a **Teacher Account** (app.classkick.com OR use the Classkick App on iOS). You can Sign-up with Google or create your own username and password.



### 3. Complete this set of teacher tasks.

A. Create an Assignment from the "+" icon in the upper right.







- Upload a PDF to a new assignment
- Upload a PDF to an existing assignment (hint: use the camera button)
- Create a new blank assignment
- Copy and add an assignment from our Assignment Library to your dashboard

#### B. Assign a Roster (this generates a Class Code)

• On Web, from the Assignments dashboard:



- On the Assignment List, Select
- o Click A+ Assign
- On Web, from Edit Assignment:



Select + ASSIGN A ROSTER



On iOS, from Whole Class View:



- Select the dropdown on the top navigation bar to assign a Roster and generate a Class Code.
- C. If creating your own assignment, add in your **questions or activities** for students. We encourage you to have no more than 1-2 questions per page.
- D. **Try features** that might work for your students (Multiple Choice, Fill in the Blank, Manipulatives or just blank canvas space).



E. Exchange class codes with a nearby teacher and practice signing in as a 'guest' student
