We work with teachers and schools to instill the value of money in students at a young age. The Council For Economic Education published nationwide financial literacy standards for grades K-12. Colorado has adopted these, and created state-wide standards called Personal Financial Literacy (PFL) standards. The problem is that teachers do not have many resources available to them when teaching this subject, which forces them to create their own curriculum.
