#### Students in this group can:

- Identify sight words, word families, and basic punctuation
- · Read aloud for short periods of time
- Understand basic plot elements
- Use picture cues to follow the plot

- Decode bigger words and read longer, more complex sentences
- Use pictures and context to infer meanings of new words
- Read to themselves for short periods of time
- · Read various informational texts

- Read fluently and confidently from text in both fiction and nonfiction genres
- Understand and follow the structure of poems and dramas
- Read to themselves for extended periods of time
- · Identify, compare, and contrast themes

- Identify letters of the alphabet and high-exposure words
- Use cover art cues to make predictions
- Understand simple settings
- · Enjoy being read to






# Students in this group can:
