

How does the WordMasters Challenge™ work?

- At each grade level, the competition consists of three 20-minute analogy-solving meets, which are held at your school three times during the year (December, February and April). Prior to each meet, students are given a list of 25 challenging vocabulary words, customized by grade and competition level.
- Excellence in the competition requires both a mastery of word meanings and thoughtful reasoning about the relationships between word list vocabulary and more familiar language used in the competition's analogies.

How are the winners of each meet determined?

- After you administer and score the analogy test at your school, you enter the scores on our website. Your team score is automatically calculated by summing the top ten individual scores.
- After each meet, we publish a summary of results and announce the team and student leaders for each grade level and division (Blue and Gold). A year-end report highlights the cumulative winners.

How can my school participate?

- It's simple! Visit wordmasterschallenge.com and click on Enroll Now. Enrollment typically runs from April through September, with Meet #1 Word Lists available for download on October 1st.
