


Administrator Dashboard

The following charts represent analysis of real classroom lessons. Administrators, Coaches and Teachers use these Ask2Learn reports, goal tracking, and collaboration tools to understand how instruction is delivered and to develop plans to grow as individual educators and as a faculty.

The report is organized into sections showing examples across the faculty, grades, and subjects. It is important to note there are no right or wrong values for each of these metrics. 
% Questions vs. Statements: All Time






All Faculty By Grade

% Content-Open Ended Questions Asked: All Time




% Observation & Theory Questions Asked: All Time






All Faculty By Subject

% Observation & Theory Questions Asked: All Time




% Content-Open Ended Questions Asked: All Time


Content Related Questions by Teacher



% Content-Open Ended Questions Asked


% Content-Narrow Questions Asked


Critical Thinking Questions By Teacher
