## EssayBuilder on-demand

package includes all the components of our software: our writing platform, on-demand courses, and daily writing prompts.

- The **StoryBuilder writing platform** takes users through the five steps of the Moments Method (Find Stories, Focus In, Tell It Out Loud, Map It, and Focus Out) to write a story. You can check out a quick demo <a href="here">here</a>.
- Our **on-demand courses** are self-guided and interactive, guiding students through the different types of college admissions essays. We also currently have two additional courses to help students with career development:

## **EssayBuilder live access**

package includes all of the above, as well unlimited access to our monthly calendar of live, online college essay bootcamps. This option puts the power in the students' hands so they can sign up for the dates and times that are most convenient for them. During each bootcamp, Story2 coaches walk students through the brainstorming, drafting, and editing processes for the different types of college essays. Students receive live feedback on their writing and are able to get their questions answered in real time!



## **EssayBuilder cohort-based course**

package allows a school to have more control by scheduling a sequence of three live, online bootcamps for their cohort of students. This sequence starts from the very beginning, with students coming up with possible topics to write about and ends with them having completed an edited draft of their personal statement. Students also have access to the Story2 on-demand software and community bootcamps.

- **Essay Essentials:** Students are introduced to the Moments Method and the role of the essay in the college admission process. They end with a brainstorm of different stories they can use for their various essays.
- **Personal Statement Bootcamp:** Students follow along with Story2 coaches in the Story2 software and write a personal statement. They end with a rough draft.
- **Essay Editing Bootcamp:** Students take their rough draft and go through the editing process alongside Story2 coaches. They end with an edited draft of their personal statement.

## **Professional development**

is broken down into four modules. Completing the first two gives educators Moments Method certification as well as access to our classroom curriculum for the school year, including six lesson plans, worksheets, and rubrics.

- 1 Introduction to Teaching the Moments Method: Educators are introduced to the Moments Method so they can teach students how to find and tell their stories for both college and career.
- 2 How to Provide Question-Based Feedback: Educators are taught how to provide question-based feedback on student essays.
- 3 Letter of Recommendation: Educators learn how to use storytelling to write effective letters of recommendation for each student.
- 4 Supplements: Educators learn how to instruct students to use storytelling for 6 different types of supplemental essays.
