Our goal was to create an interactive learning site that appeals to students as well as educators. We invite you to explore the website for free and let us know what you think.



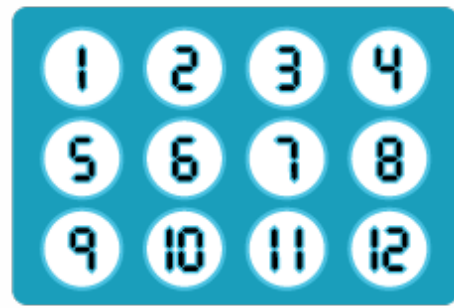
**What is I Know It?**

"I know It" is a math practice website for students in Kindergarten through 5th grade. When students answer math problems correctly, an animated character celebrates their success by jumping and dancing. When they answer incorrectly, they are presented with an easy-to-understand graphical explanation. Teachers who are members can set up student accounts, assign lessons, and monitor their student's progress.



**Can I try the site for free?**

Yes, you can sign up for a [30-day free trial](#). There's no catch, and no commitment. We do not ask for a credit card information when you set up your account.



**Can I try the lessons without signing up or logging in?**

Students can answer up to 12 questions per day before logging in is required. Their results are not tracked unless they are logged in. Members who log in can create accounts for each of their students, view student score, and track their progress.



**My students can see the grade level of each lesson. Is it possible to hide this?**

When a student logs in with his or her own account, grade levels of the lessons are hidden.



**Is there a feature that allows questions to be read aloud?**

Yes. Simply click the little speaker icon  next to the question text.



**Is there a "work space" feature that allows students to show/draw their work on screen?**

Yes, but only if you're viewing the website on a table with a touch screen (such as an ipad). Simply click the pencil icon and the work space appears. We do not have a workspace feature for desktop, laptop, and Chromebook versions of the website. Generally, these devices do not have touch screens and it would be difficult for students to show their work by drawing it with a computer mouse.



**Who built this site?**

We're the same team that built and operates SuperTeacherWorksheets.com. Our team consists of a handful of teachers, graphic artists, computer programmers, and customer support staff. All questions were written by experienced, professional elementary school teachers. We've even tested the site with students in a classroom setting.




**What devices can I use to access "I Know It."**

"I Know It" is optimized for laptops, Chromebooks, iPads, and desktop computers. It also works on mobile phones, but some features may be limited.



**Are the lessons aligned to the Common Core Standards?**

Yes. To view Common Core standards associated with a given lesson, simply click the  icon next to the lesson's name. We've also noted alignments to Florida and Texas standards as well. (When you log in as a member, you can toggle between Common Core, Texas, and Florida standards.)



**How much does a subscription cost?**

Membership is affordable. Individual teachers pay only \$150 per year for their whole class. Whole school and district licenses are sold on per-student pricing.
