How to improve pronunciation with authentic context





Challenge

Young learners in Argentina face difficulties in mastering the pronunciation of the new language due to the lack of authentic context.

Solution

Making the authentic context of English an essential part of their everyday lives in a way that engages the new generation of media users.

The year is **2023**, and we are in a private primary and secondary school in the heart of Argentina's capital city, Buenos Aires.

Did you know that Argentina, unlike many neighbouring countries, teaches English as a second language following the British curriculum and dialect? The importance of English learning is undeniable by now, and while many schools prioritize ESL in their curriculum, children have limited opportunities to practice the language and no authentic exposure to practice and pronunciation.

Alfredo is the head of the English teaching department of Escuela Scholem Aleijem in Buenos Aires, a private institution where English teaching is a priority. The facility is well-equipped with modern technologies: interactive smartboards in the classrooms, and tablets/laptops are available for the students. Their 1200 pupils start learning English as a second language at preschool, ages 3-5. The importance of the quality of education is number 1 on the school's list, providing amazing materials and teaching methods delivered by great educators. Oh, and the results. 


CHALLENGE NUMBER 1

Pronunciation is a pain point due to the lack of exposure to authentic spoken English







SOLUTION

In 2022 they implemented BOOKR Class, an award-winning English teaching and learning tool created by the Europe-based edtech startup BOOKR Kids.

The students at Scholem Aleijem receive great support from their tutors and are highly skilled in English grammar and vocabulary. Pronunciation and speaking skills, however, are an area that Alfredo was keen on improving.

Students don't speak much, they learn a lot of grammar, but they lack the oral skills.

We've experienced a 45 % points improvement in reading comprehension, as well as a striking rise (68%) in their performance in pronunciation.

BOOKR CLASS CONSISTS OF TWO MAIN PARTS:


- a Library application with 1000+ graded books for children aged 4-14, accompanied by educational games and exercises to help practice all 4 skills of language acquisition.
- and a Teacher's Dashboard, a clever admin site for educators to look for materials, assign and track performance.

The stories are all narrated by native speakers: actors, and storytellers to make the stories more engaging and expose children to the correct pronunciation - without them even noticing. The text is highlighted so the readers match sentences/expressions with the sounds more easily.

We found that reading and listening help to address this issue - students listen to the story and become more confident speaking. We can see a great shift ever since we started using BOOKR Class in our classes.

CHALLENGE NUMBER 2

Teachers were reluctant to use new technology tools in their classes

One of the most striking advantages of BOOKR is that it enables teachers to change classroom dynamics, especially during the daily routines. The question "What book or books have you read?" triggers a lot of class discussion and rich language work in class.

Educators at Scholem Aleijem were reluctant to use new digital tools in their classes, 'but once they logged in, they loved it' - explains Alfredo.

We tried other reading apps but they were difficult to use and quite overwhelming for our teachers. There were so many materials and it was not easy to navigate.

BOOKR is User-friendly and easy to adapt to any environment and device - which was a great success with my colleagues as it was one less factor to worry about during classes."










CHALLENGE NUMBER 3

Students realize the importance of the English language but are reluctant to stay focused and actively participate in classes, which shows in their results as well



Today's learners, who grew up surrounded by media everywhere they looked, have become highly skilled and selective. They identify what interests them and focus on content that captures their attention and keeps them interested and engaged for the duration of a whole lesson.

We utilize BOOKR Class in many different ways to make sure students fully emerge in the process. The material itself is very engaging, with sounds, animations, and games - it all makes the class very interactive. Our students just love it!

For the smaller grades and kindergartens, they prioritize the song format of the stories, BOOKR even has a Karaoke version for most of these stories.



For higher primary school groups, BOOKR's role is threefold:
