

Give the Gift of Learning to Those Who Need It Most

- > \$1.3 million in membership fee waivers to families in need.
- > 70% of schools we serve have large student populations that are eligible for reduced lunch.
- > More than 1,000 blind or visually impaired students are served through the College Success Program.
- > 1,200 volunteers donated over 75,000 hours of service in 2018
- > 2013-2018 cost per student served DECREASED BY 86%
