As a result, we also offer time-limited professional development and coaching focused on such topics as performance assessment, aligned performance tasks, common rubrics, project-based learning, leadership and culture, and Common Core integration. Typically, these services are tailored specifically for your teachers and leaders based on a needs assessment.


