How Empatico Works

Empatico is a free tool for educators to connect their classrooms with others around the world. We make it simple for virtual connections to exist in classrooms by combining everything needed in one platform: live video, file sharing, a partner classroom, and activities.

We focus on ages 6-11 because children at this age are old enough to understand their role in the world, but young enough to be positively influenced by experiences.



The Activities

Empatico activities help students learn and practice crucial life skills such as perspective taking, critical thinking, cooperation, and respectful communication.

Empatico provides students with the opportunity to learn about different perspectives and practice interpersonal skills that are crucial for building cross-cultural relationships later in life.
